



Day 01: Hyderabad City Tour

Hyderabad, The city of Nizams is one of the oldest cities not just in India but in the world. A city that has almost everything to offer its visitors, Hyderabad makes for one of the most interesting places to visit. A blend of rich cultural and historical heritages, age old traditions and best of modern facilities, the city of Hyderabad presents an environment that is unmatched to any. Another important aspect of a trip to Hyderabad is its cuisine. Hyderabad cuisines and the world famous biryani will pamper your palate in the best way possible. Hyderabad tours offer tourists with more than just a travelling experience.

- Qutub Shahi Tombs One of the oldest monuments of Hyderabad; tombs of seven Qutub Shahi rulers presenting a beautiful blend of Persian and Indian architectural styles.
- Golconda Fort First built by Kakatiya dynasty later developed by Qutub Shahi Kings. Attractions- sound and light show in night; Water supply system, 'Rahban' cannon, Ramdas' prison. (You can also view our team created video on Golconda Fort here). It would take at least half day here.
- Salar Jung Museum 3rd largest museum in India with 43000 art objects (Indian Art, Far Eastern Art, European Art, Middle Eastern Art, etc.), 9000 manuscripts and 47000 printed books, spread in 38 galleries. Not to be missed- Veiled marble statue of Rebecca, 19th C British Musical Clock, etc.
- Charminar Built in 1591 by Sultan Mohammed Quli Qutb Shah in the honour of his wife Bhagmati. Also known as known as 'Arc de Triumph of the East'
- Mecca Masjid constructed by Sultan Muhammad Quli Qutub Shah in 1614; one of the largest mosques in the world. To see - Belgian crystal chandeliers, intricately designed arches, tombs to Asif shah dynasty.
- Laad Bazaar Situated close to Charminar, Laad Bazaar is a place famous for bangles and many other traditional items which makes it a shopper's paradise. Stretched across on four roads this starts from Charminar and spreads across at least one kilometer.



This market showcases the living heritage of the city and it is believed that this market exists since the time of Qutub Shahis and era of Nizams and now it is one of the major places to shop bangles made of Lacquer or Laad from where the name has been derived.

Day 02: Ramoji Film City

Ramoji Film City is one of the most famous tourist attractions of the state and also one of the dream locations for all movie lovers in the country. Ramoji is the largest film city in the world and the proof is in the form of a Guinness World Record certificate painted on one of their walls.

You can majorly divide the tour into three divisions: the Bus Tour, Movie Magic, and Sahas Adventures. This will take a minimum of 6 hours and a maximum of 9 hours, depending on you. However, it will not be wrong to say that every minute spent here is worth it.



ITINERARY / SCHEDULE - DAY WISE

There is enough flora and fauna in the 1440 acres of Ramoji Land, but there are also sanctuaries with different species of birds and butterflies for you to see.

There are ostriches and their eggs. You'd also find many kinds of ducks, peacocks, pigeons and parrots, living in a limited space. There are gardens full of different kinds of flowers and bonsai trees. There are also a few shops for you to take souvenirs back home. After this tour, you can take a bus back to Eureka.

There are many restaurants and a drive-in near Eureka, where you can eat to regain your energy for the next tour. After lunch comes Movie Magic. Here you get to see the movie making process, a magic show and a trip into space. You can even volunteer to be a part of the movie-making process, fulfilling your dream of being in a movie.

The Sahas Adventures start at 14.30 sharp, and the sooner you reach here, the more accessible all the activities would be. The most highly rated adventures are Bungee Ejection, Zip Lining, High Rope Course, and Net Course. You can buy your individual tickets at the Sahas Adventures entry counter if you have not taken it with your entry tickets. There are many other fun activities at Sahas including ATV (all-terrain vehicle) rides, archery, shooting, paintball, mountain biking, etc.

Best Sequence to Cover Things:

- Start with sightseeing as soon as you enter the film city. It will save you from the afternoon heat, as you will finish before 12.00 hrs.
- Eat at the lunch buffet at Dil Se or any other restaurant.
- You can next go and watch the filmmaking techniques in Movie Magic and finish the Space Yatra before 14.00 hrs.
- Next, you can visit Sahas Adventures. It starts from 14.30hrs and doesn't attract crowds till 15.30 hrs.
- After Sahas, you can go back to Eureka and get a foot and calf massage, enjoy some fun rides, and the park.

ITINERARY / SCHEDULE - DAY WISE

Things to Keep In Mind:

- If you do not want to waste time in queues, reach Ramoji Film City by 09.00 hrs.
- Make sure you wear comfortable shoes, as you will need to walk on different terrains.
- Wear casual and comfortable clothes, fit for adventure activities. Avoid black due to the heat.
- Have breakfast before you leave for Ramoji, as the venue will only serve patties, chips, and popcorn during the tour.
- Carry a bottle of water to keep yourself hydrated, and a pair of shades in case your eyes are sun-sensitive.

After completion of the Tour in the Evening, you will be dropped to the Hotel.

Day 03: Hyderabad City Tour

After Breakfast, you are picked up from the Hotel and you will be visiting the following places:

Nehru Zoological Park - A home to about 1500 odd animals across various species, Nehru Zoological Park is one of the must visit attractions on a Hyderabad city tour. Spread across an area of about 380 acres, it also happens to be one of the largest zoos in the whole of Asia.

Snow World - Considered to be one-of-a-kind Hyderabad attractions, Snow World is an unique amusement park located in the heart of the city and right next to the Hussain Sagar Lake. Spread across a land of about 2 acres, Snow World promises a fun-filled day amidst the snow for friends, families, and all travelers alike.

Lumbini Park - A modern urban park located at the core of the city, Lumbini Park is one of the refreshing places to visit in Hyderabad in evening. Letting the locals unwind after a tiring day and entertaining the travelers with the magical light and sound show, the park is dedicated to Lord Buddha and is named after Lumbini of Nepal.



NTR Gardens - Of all the places to visit in Hyderabad, NTR Gardens is comparatively a newest addition to the family of tourist attractions in the city. Dedicated and built in the memory of Late Shri N.T. Rama Rao, a visit to the lush NTR Gardens is a must for those who're in search for a place to revive their mind, body, and soul.

Hussain Sagar Lake - Considered to be one of the largest man-made lakes in the heart of the city, Hussain Sagar Lake is one of the most romantic places to visit in Hyderabad for couples. Other than offering majestic views of the massive Buddha statue located in middle of the lake, one can also enjoy boating and parasailing activities that also makes it one of the most happening places to visit in Hyderabad at night.
